

INSPIRE MANAK Scheme – Work Flow

Step 1: Awareness & Capacity Building

Schools and teachers are oriented about the scheme and its objectives.

Step 2: Internal School-Level Screening

Each school conducts an internal idea competition to identify and nominate best original ideas from students **(Classes 6 to 12)**. A maximum of **5 ideas per school** can be submitted on the portal.

Step 3: Submission on E-MIAS Portal

Schools upload student nominations via the official portal.

Step 4: Shortlisting & Fund Transfer

Top **1,00,000** ideas are shortlisted nationally. Each selected student receives **₹10,000** through PFMS to develop a prototype.

Step 5: District Level Exhibition and Project Competition (DLEPC)

Selected students present their innovations. Top **10%** of ideas move forward to the state level.

Step 6: State Level Exhibition and Project Competition (SLEPC)

Students exhibit refined models. Top **10%** ideas are selected for the national level.

Step 7: Mentorship Workshops

Mentoring support is provided to selected students by reputed technology institutions to help improve their innovations before the national event.

Step 8: National Level Exhibition and Project Competition (NLEPC)

Top **1,000** ideas are showcased at the national platform. Final top **60** innovations are selected.

Step 9: Incubation Support

The top 60 ideas receive further support for incubation, product/process development.

Step 10: Festival of Innovation and Entrepreneurship (FINE)

Final 60 innovations are showcased at FINE and may be linked with other DST/NIF platforms for wider impact.
