

Guidelines for correctly writing the Idea/Innovation Title and Synopsis in the nomination form

The purpose of including the **'Title'** and **'Synopsis'** in the nomination form is to provide a clear understanding of the idea or innovation being submitted. Therefore, proper care must be taken while filling in these details.

The **title** should clearly describe the idea or innovation, for example, *'A device to climb Areca nut trees'* or *'An assistive walking aid for the elderly.'* Broad themes such as Agriculture, Swachh Bharat, Swastha Bharat, or Digital India should be avoided.

The synopsis should include the following points: *what the Idea/innovation is about, the problem it addresses, and the advantage or benefit it offers.*

Title of the Idea/Innovation: Travelling Bag with Folding Seats

Idea/Innovation Synopsis:

Many a times, travelers have to stand while waiting for a bus or train at stations, as the number of available seats is limited. To address this, the student has developed a travelling bag with an integrated folding seat. This seat can be unfolded and used while waiting, thereby reducing the discomfort of standing for a long time. It will be especially useful for ladies and the elderly.

Other documents e.g. Idea/innovation photo, sketches, if available, may be uploaded.

Filling the nomination form correctly is crucial for proper evaluation during the online screening process.

Remember, all ideas are initially screened online, without the student being present to explain the idea or innovation.
